MISSIONAL LEADERSHIP: CULTIVATING SOCIAL IMPACT COMMUNITIES

This community of emerging learners will journey together for over ten months, where they will undergo a series of Kingswell modules, one-on-one coaching, and frequent collaborative gatherings. This year's emphasis is cultivating *Social Impact Communities*. This journey is designed to do the following:

- **Retool** emerging leaders with the hardware necessary to mentor and disciple more effectively in one's context.
- **Equip** emerging leaders on how to sustain a missional community in one's context through mentoring relationships.
- **Inspire** emerging leaders to be innovators and catalysts of renewal within their cities and neighborhoods.

Training Objectives:

- Understand the biblical, theological, and historical foundations of missional leadership and mentoring/discipleship.
- Evaluate the paradigms that drive our church systems, forms, and practices, then apply missional methodologies to our existing systems and new unexplored contexts for the Kingdom of God.
- Understand poverty and how to alleviate it.
- Exhibit a passionate spirituality that reflects the characteristics of Jesus and one that is contagious for equipping others to follow Jesus.
- Deploy a discipleship strategy specific to one's context by discerning and applying the appropriate mentoring styles for the community from an unbiased, pure, and loving motive.
- Embrace the New Testament vision of Jesus' Spirit-anointed ministry being the basis for one's own life and mission.
- Cultivate and sustain new forms of missional-incarnational life and ministry in one's neighborhood.

BASIC PATHWAY: The following pathway will guide you toward completing this training:

Orientation: To jumpstart your immersion into this cohort, you'll meet as a team online, learn about the program, know how you're wired, and then connect with a coach.

Monthly Coaching: Meeting online (or face-to-face) with your coach once a month for 60 minutes each.

Kingswell Modules:

A module is a gathering of learners who meet online for five weeks. This is a time of teaching, discussion, and reading with cohort members, complemented by individual projects to help inspire ideas for cultivating disciples and impacting one's context. Learners will complete these four Kingswell modules:

- **Missional Thinking & Practice**
- **Art and Practice of Gathering & Convening People**
- **Understanding and Alleviating Poverty**
- **Engaging your Neighborhood for Change**

Social Impact Community: Two online practicums designed to explore the program's emphasis

- **Discover and Design the Concept**
- **Develop and deploy the Concept**

One-Day Cluster:

Two times during the training, we will meet as a cohort for a one-day residency (once in the Winter and once in the Summer). We will meet with other cohort members and special guests for face-to-face interaction, teaching, and sharing over food to discuss the highs and lows of one's journey, readings, and experiences.

Exit Interview:

Upon completing the 10-month journey, there will be an exit interview with three (3) other coaches, including a sending church representative, to discuss your experience throughout the program and what/how you intend to implement from your training.

Costs:
